About the choir:

The Sudbury Chamber Singers were formed in 1975 by artistic director and conductor Dr. Douglas Webb and are now celebrating their 40th anniversary. A wide variety of music has been performed over the years, including masses, requiems, madrigals, gospel, folk music, pop songs and more. Typically two main concerts per year – one before Christmas and the second in the spring - and often additional special events are performed. The choir performs both a-cappella and with accompaniment, sometimes with additional guest performers. The group consists of about 25 choir members.

Profile for artistic director:

We are looking for an artistic director who will build on the history and lead the choir into the next phase making excellent music with vision and energy, and sustain the choir's culture of shared ownership, collaboration and mutual respect.

- Strong artistic and musical leadership skills (choose music, musical education and vocal instructions including choir warmup, audition/re-audition members as needed)
- Communicative, connective and inspiring leadership style
- Collaborate with executive members and librarian on technical aspects, grant applications, selection of guest artists, etc.


- 1.) A letter outlining your interest and qualification for the position.
